

# House Leader (HL)

## **Position Summary:**

The House Leader (HL) is a member of the Tyndale University Undergraduate Student Association (TUUSA) Council. As a student leader they are responsible to promote the vision and mission of the Council, represent students, strive for excellence in their academics, and to model the standards set in the Tyndale Student Handbook.

The HL's primary responsibility is to provide leadership, community development, and spiritual formational opportunities for their designated House (Adrian, Boehmer, Harris, McRae, and Stiller). They are also responsible for actively seeking out the concerns and ideas of the students within their House and to bring them to the Council for discussion.

The House Leader is responsible to the student body, the TUUSA Council, the Coordinator of Spiritual Development and the Community Life Coordinator.

# **Student Leadership Responsibilities:**

- Attend spring, fall, winter, and spring student leadership training sessions
- Attend fall and winter student leadership getaway
- Attend monthly student leadership meetings
- Meet weekly with the Coordinator of Spiritual Development and Student Mentoring (Coordinator)
- Meet in pairs with the Community Life Coordinator once a semester.
- Assist with facilitating different activities during Orientation Week
- Attend chapels and community gatherings on a regular basis

#### **Appointment Responsibilities:**

- Meet regularly with your co-house leader to set goals, plan events, and build community
- Provide overall leadership to the House.
  - Offer support and vision to the House
  - Facilitate weekly gatherings on Thursdays, such as House Lunches and House Hangouts
  - Lead regular social activities and interactions with the House
  - Journey with and support first year students through their first year of studies
  - Assist and be available for leading INDS House Small groups as directed by the Dean of Student Life
  - Offer support (devotional, emotional, academic (as appropriate), and relational) to members of the House.

- o Promote and help facilitate House Challenges (2-3 a semester).
- Plan and organize at least one House gathering per semester (an event that promotes opportunities for building community. i.e. worship night, bowling, games night, spa night, etc.)
- Help with set up and take down with two to three EO-run events in the academic year.
- Help with set up or take down of the end of Fall semester event and Spring Banquet.
- This service opportunity will demand a minimum of 5 hours a week each semester.

## Qualifications

- A cumulative GPA of 2.30 and current GPA of 2.00. If the student's cumulative GPA is less than 2.3 then the student must have a current GPA of 2.7.
- Good financial standing with Tyndale
- Good standing with chapel attendance.
- Able to return to campus before fall and winter semesters start for training and/or retreats
- Able to take initiative and think creatively.
- Be a good role model for students.
- Commitment to Tyndale's mission and vision.
- Desire for personal growth
- Organization is beneficial and small group leadership is beneficial
- Professing Christian with demonstrated spiritual maturity.
- Uphold and adhere to the statements, standards, and guidelines set out in the Student Handbook.
- Conflict resolution skills are beneficial.
- Leadership experience is beneficial.
