The Christian Ministries minor is intended to give excellent practical training in one of four specific ministry foci without sacrificing solid academic strength. Students desiring to enter into ministry as their vocation will wish to complete a Christian Ministries minor with a major in Biblical Studies and Theology. Students desiring practical ministry training as a complement to their chosen major, such as English, Business, or Psychology, may take the Christian Ministries minor to achieve this goal.
